

# Laminated stitch

This is an opportunity to explore and experiment with laminated stitch and discover how you could include this contemporary technique in your own textile work.



Alex has based this workshop around a wall hanging created on a coastal theme, but you can introduce floral or other. Everyone will start a contemporary laminated wall piece combining materials such as painted Bondaweb, metallic sheers and sequin waste with machine and hand stitching. There will be loads of stitch and the day is jam packed with lots of techniques to include water soluble work, painting as well as machine and hand stitch. Alex will show how these panels can be completed at home.

Alex will supply the materials kit for £7.00.

Requirements: In addition to the materials pack, you will need to bring:

- Sewing machine with free machine embroidery foot and normal presser foot
- Embroidery scissors
- Optional - anything flat you would like to laminate such as painted papers, metallic tissue papers and sequins
